This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. In this connection, I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Extension of General Affiliation as per details given below:-

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 17 of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes and further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law subject to availability of class rooms of greater than 500 ft dimension.
2	The provision for lift is under process. Therefore, the school is directed installed the same as per RPWD Act and Board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance with videography.

3	It is appearing that the CwSN toilets for boy and girls are located to adjacent to each other with common entry point, which is not acceptable (video ref time 17:35). Further, CwSN shown by school for girls is not CwSN friendly as it is without handrail and without proper space for easy movement of wheelchair and path leading to boy's CwSN toilet is narrow. The school shall make provision for separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and Board's guidelines and submit compliance within 3 months on SARAS with videography.
4	The school has high enrollment in few classes whereas as per Affiliation Bye laws of the Board the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 40 students as per circular dated 02-08-2023. Therefore, the school is directed to follow the enrollment of students class/section wise as per Board's norms and submit the undertaking on its letterhead within 03 months in the compliance.
5	Biology lab is without work stations with utilities.Exhaust fans, fire extinguishers are not seen in chemistry , bio and composite labs.Curtains which are a fire hazard should be removed. The school shall upgrade the labs as per SoPs issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
6	The school is required to improve the drinking water facilities and outdoor game facilities (as per Board's SoP) within 03 months and submit the compliance.
7	The school shall upgrade the library as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
8	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Prayagraj within 3 months and submit the compliance

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws- 2018.

2. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School is required to apply on online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school is required to renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
8. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

“The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate and Building safety certificate during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms”.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
